| Over the past 2 months we have experienced a higher number of truck and cargo thefts within the 31 division area. Everyone both in the trucking industry and the business community need to work together with the police to prevent these and other types of crime. | | |

Below are some valuable Prevention Tips to help prevent these types of crimes.

Take Preventative Action While On The Road

More and more trucks and cargo are being hijacked when on the road or stolen while parked.

Do you:

- Have devices that can immobilize your equipment and are they used?
(Today there are many devices that can be used to immobilize your equipment, make yourself aware of these devices and regularly use them.)
- Have a procedure in place to require a vehicle to be locked at all times, using quality locks?
- Demand that drivers lock the power unit and remove the keys when it is left unattended?
- Demand that your drivers do not discuss the freight, its value or its destination, with anyone while on the road?
- Park trailers in unsupervised areas or have approved drop off sites?
- Park trailers in the yard - up to the dock, back to back, etc?
- Lock trailers after loading, using quality locks (multiple pin tumblers, dead locking bolts, interchangeable cores) marked with your company identification?
- Have route planning with scheduled stops, and are different routes selected so that a routine pattern is not established?
- Advise drivers to report anything that is suspicious, particularly strangers asking questions about the load or destination?
- Adequately identify your vehicle with your company name and unit number?
