**COMMUNITY
ALERT !**



COMMUNITY ALERT is a computer operated information system being utilized within the 31 Division area of Toronto. It is maintained and upgraded with donations made by the community and is housed and operated by the 31 Division Police Station.

The **COMMUNITY ALERT** system uses a telephone autodialer, fax and e-mail to inform citizens, businesses and community organizations about incidents of crime and other information important to the community. For example, citizens may be informed about children or elderly persons reported missing, robberies or assaults, break-ins, tips on crime prevention, and community meetings taking place within their area.

The telephone autodialer system for residential use, operates between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M., and sends a one minute recorded message to your phone, providing you with current information. If your phone is busy or unanswered, the system will call back several times. It will also leave the message on an answering machine.

The fax service, for business and other organizations, along with the e-mail service operate 24 hours a day to better serve the community.

In order to participate in the **COMMUNITY ALERT** program, you are required to complete, sign and return the consent form on the back of this page. The information you provide on this form will be maintained under police security.

The program is free; no contribution is required to register. If you do wish to contribute, however, a space has been provided on the consent form for this purpose. Any donation will assist in the maintenance and continuation of the program.

Experience has shown that the improved communications provided by this type of program has not only helped to reduce the frequency of criminal incidents in a particular area, but has assisted the police in apprehending wanted persons.
