# \$50,000 REWARD

ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 3, 2008, AT 12:18 P.M., POLICE RESPONDED TO AN UNKNOWN TROUBLE CALL AT AN APARTMENT BUILDING ON COIN STREET. OFFICERS ATTENDED AND LOCATED A 72-YEAR-OLD MAN SUFFERING FROM OBVIOUS SIGNS OF TRAUMA. HE WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD AT THE SCENE.

ACCORDING TO EVERYONE IN THE BUILDING, RICHARD CLEMENTS WAS A KIND, GENTLE AND GENEROUS MAN WHO HELPED ANYONE WHO NEEDED IT. EVEN THOUGH RICHARD WAS A DOUBLE AMPUTEE, HE WAS VERY MOBILE USING HIS WHEELCHAIRS. RICHARD WAS LAST SEEN ALIVE ON THE EVENING OF DECEMBER 2, 2008 AT 9:00 P.M.

HIS COMMUNITY IS SHOCKED AND HORRIFIED ABOUT HIS MURDER AND DEMAND JUSTICE.

HOMICIDE INVESTIGATORS BELIEVE THAT THERE ARE A NUMBER OF WITNESSES WHO MAY HAVE CRUCIAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EVENTS OF THE EVENING OF DECEMBER 2, 2008, WHO HAVE NOT YET COME FORWARD. THE INVESTIGATORS ENCOURAGE THESE WITNESSES TO CONTACT THEM DIRECTLY SO THAT THIS INVESTIGATION COULD BE BROUGHT TO A SUCCESSFUL CONCLUSION WITH THE KILLER OF RICHARD CLEMENTS BROUGHT TO JUSTICE.



RICHARD CLEMENTS

*I AM AUTHORIZING A REWARD OF UP TO FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) FROM THE TORONTO POLICE SERVICE FOR EVIDENCE LEADING TO THE IDENTIFICATION, ARREST AND CONVICTION OF THE PERSON(S) RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS MURDER. THIS REWARD IS RESTRICTED TO ONLY THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE NOT PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED A STATEMENT TO THE TORONTO POLICE SERVICE PERTAINING TO THIS INVESTIGATION. EMPLOYEES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND CORRECTIONAL AGENCIES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COLLECT THIS REWARD. THE REWARD IS PAYABLE IN CANADIAN FUNDS AND EXPIRES ON JULY 7TH, 2010 AND SHALL BE APPORTIONED AS THE TORONTO POLICE SERVICE DEEMS JUST. CLAIMS WILL BE RECOGNIZED ONLY WHEN MADE IN WRITING PRIOR TO THE EXPIRY DATE.*
