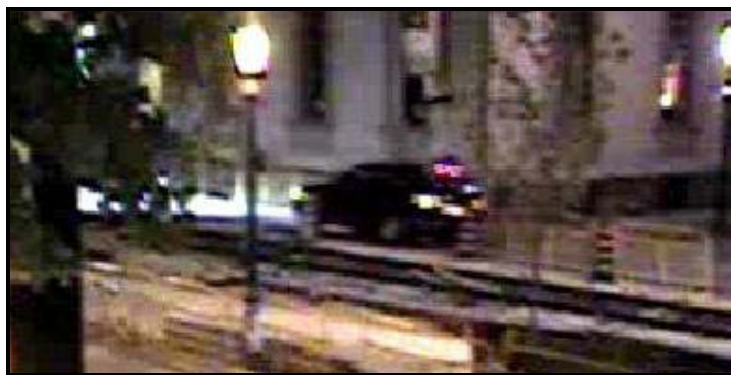

On Sunday, October 18th, 2009 at approximately 3:05 am, Toronto Police responded to the intersection of Adelaide Street East and Victoria Street for a pedestrian struck - fail to remain collision. Upon arrival Christopher Skinner was found to be suffering from injuries sustained from being run over by a vehicle. He was transported to Hospital where he later died.

Earlier in the evening Chris had been celebrating his sister’s birthday in the Entertainment District. After the celebrations he began to walk eastbound alone on Adelaide Street towards his home. It is believed that Chris was trying to hail a cab just east of Yonge Street when his hand may have come in contact with the suspect vehicle, a black SUV. This black SUV stopped just west of Victoria Street and the suspects got out. Chris approached the suspects and a brief altercation took place. Chris was pushed to the ground and kicked. The suspects got back in their SUV and drove eastbound over Chris’ body. The SUV was last seen eastbound Adelaide Street approaching Church Street.

Christopher Skinner was a talented young man, engaged to be married and well loved by his friends and family. There has been a tremendous outpouring of grief over his loss.

The Chief of Police, William Blair has authorized a reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) from the Toronto Police Service for evidence leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for this murder. The reward is payable in Canadian Funds and expires on December 8th, 2010, and shall be apportioned as the Toronto Police Service deems just. Claims will be recognized only when made in writing prior to the expiry date.

*The following persons are not eligible to collect this reward (ineligible claimants): Employees of law enforcement agencies, and their immediate family members; employees of correctional institutions and their immediate family members. This includes volunteer staff and their immediate family members. Immediate family member means a spouse, partner, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild or sibling, and include persons related through marriage (step and in-law relationships) and adoption.*
