\$50,000 REWARD



On Monday May 10, 2010 at approximately 11:59 am the victim, Li-Yuan (Rose) LIU, was working in the dry cleaning store she owned and operated at 3430 Finch Ave East, in the City Of Toronto. An unknown suspect entered the store and violently attacked LIU, leaving her to die from her injuries. Video surveillance captured an image of the suspect prior to and after the murder.



Li-Yuan (Rose) LIU was a wife and mother to 3 adult children.

An extensive investigation has failed to lead to an arrest of the person(s) responsible for this murder.

Investigators require the assistance from members of the community to come forward with evidence that would lead to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for this killing.

The Chief of Police, William Blair, has authorized a reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) from the Toronto Police Service for evidence leading to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the death of Li-Yuan LIU. *(The following persons are not eligible to collect this reward (ineligible claimants): employees of law enforcement agencies, and their immediate family members; employees of correctional institutions and their immediate family members. This includes volunteer staff and their immediate family members. Immediate family member means a spouse, partner, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild or sibling, and include persons related through marriage (step and in-law relationships) and adoption).*

The reward is payable in Canadian Funds and expires on October 13, 2012, and shall be apportioned as the Toronto Police Service deems just. Claims will be recognized only when made in writing prior to the expiry date.
