



Three men face 47 charges in firearm investigation, Loaded handgun and drugs seized.

On Thursday, November 5, 2009, at 2 a.m., officers from 54 Division's Major Crime Unit, with assistance from the Emergency Task Force, executed a search warrant in the Warden Road/Danforth Road area.

It is alleged that:

– officers located a loaded handgun, ammunition, two bulletproof vests, pepper spray, brass knuckles and a quantity of crack cocaine, ecstasy and marijuana.

Travis Carmichael, 19; Alexander Liburd, 19; and Teresa Snooks, 22; all of Toronto, are each charged with:

- 1) Possession of Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking,
- 2) Possession of Cocaine,
- 3) Possession of Ecstasy for the Purpose of Trafficking,
- 4) Possession of Ecstasy,
- 5) Possession of Marijuana,
- 6) Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm,
- 7) Possession of a Firearm knowing its possession is unauthorized,
- 8) Possession of a Restricted Weapon with Ammunition,
- 9) Unauthorized Possession of a Restricted Weapon,
- 10) Careless Storage of a Firearm,
- 11) Careless Storage of Ammunition,
- 12) Two counts of Unauthorized Possession of a Prohibited Weapon,
- 13) Possess Firearm with Defaced Serial Number.

Travis Carmichael is also charged with:

- 1) Possession of Marijuana,
- 2) Two counts of Fail to Comply with a Recognizance.

Alexander Liburd is also charged with:

- 1) Possession Proceeds of Crime,

- 2) two counts of Fail to Comply with a Recognizance,
- 3) two counts of Fail to Comply with Probation.

They were scheduled to appear in court at Old City Hall, on Thursday, November 5, 2009, room 103, at 10 a.m.
