Stolen medication**

The Toronto Police Service would like to make the public aware of a quantity of stolen medication.

It is reported that:

- between Saturday, January 30, 2010 and Tuesday, February 2, 2010, the suspect(s) stole a quantity of medication in the Dufferin Street/King Street West area.
- 120 Oxycontin tablets (20 mg)
- 60 Fluconazole tablets (100 mg)
- 60 Tramacet tablets (325 mg)

The stolen medication could be harmful or fatal if ingested, especially to children.
