

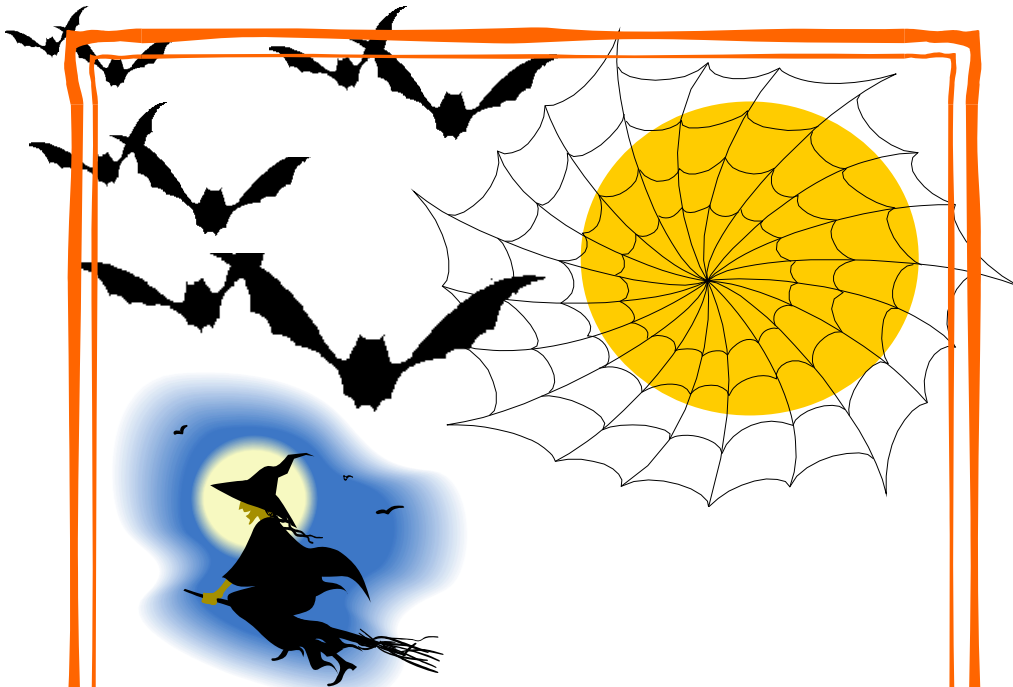

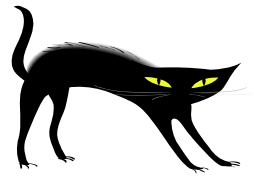

Safety Tips



Costumes should be short enough
so you don't trip and fall.
Costume parts should be made
from soft material.



Use face paint or makeup
instead of a mask.
Masks make it hard for you to
see where you're going.



Always be aware of what's going
on around you.



Watch out for cars. Remember that it may be hard for drivers to see you. Walk - never run.



Trick or treat in your own neighbourhood. Never take shortcuts through backyards, alleys or parks.



Always trick or treat with a parent or trusted adult.
