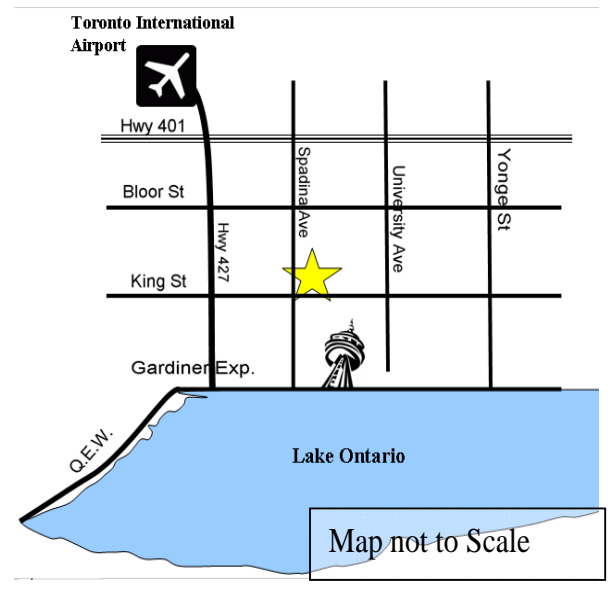

The Toronto Police Service, Fugitive Squad and United States Marshals Service are pleased to be hosting the 12th Annual International Fugitive Investigators Conference at the Hyatt Regency Toronto Hotel in Toronto, Ontario, from May 18 - 20, 2010.

Registration fees are \$380.00 US or CDN equivalent per person. At present, registration is limited to 350 participants with a registration cut off date of **April 10th, 2010**. Any registrations received after that date will be dealt with on a "first come, first serve basis", according to available space. Registration **includes a banquet dinner** at the hotel on the Thursday evening (May 20th, 2010).
